Since your wedding celebration is both a personal and a Church and parish event, the music you choose for the celebration in church should have a sacred character, speaking about the spiritual dimension of the commitment into which you are entering.

Contemporary, non-religious music selections are therefore not appropriate. The final decision in such matters is left to our parish's Music Director, Mrs. Diane Larkin at 631-662-7348. Please leave a message with your name and reference **Wedding**.

Mrs. Larkin will be happy to help you with your planning. Mrs. Larkin will contact you via text/e-mail and will send you a list of music to listen to. Please arrange your musical selections and speak with Mrs. Larkin **at least two months** prior to your wedding.

Musicians

Our music staff will provide both an organist and a soloist for the wedding. If you wish to add additional singers, or instumentalists, arrangements must be made with Mrs. Larkin well in advance. She will inform you of the stipend for additional instumentalists and singers, should you desire them.

It is our parish policy that our own music staff must be compensated, even if a guest provides the music.

Church Offering

The offering for your wedding is broken down as follows:

\$600 supports the Church – check made out to St. Philip Neri Parish

(\$750 if you are from out of the parish)

\$175 is the fee for the organist – (cash please)

\$175 is the fee for the singer – (cash please)

\$45 is given to the Sacristan – (cash please)

\$20 is given to the altar server – (cash please)

All wedding fees are received at the parish at your final interview before the wedding.

Couples often ask about a gratuity for the priest or deacon celebrating their wedding. While this is not necessary, it is certainly appreciated.
